Dev team goals:

- Release quality / consistency
- Improve performance in key areas
- Develop new product features

Release Quality

Process Changes

Automated build

- Less error-prone
- Less time consuming
- Deployment consistency
- More frequent releases

Automated testing

- Repeatable
- Increasing coverage over time
- More Coverage = Fewer Regressions

Code Branches

Performance

Eliminate long waits when searching

- Database tuning to handle ever-increasing amounts of data
- Dramatic improvements in Premium Content & Interactions Finders
 - average 85% reduction in query time, sometimes as high as 98%
- More to come!

Premium Content

- Improved technology to receive full-text content
 - Forrester
 - Gartner
 - 451 Research
- New way to search for analyst quotes
 - LexisNexis
- Overall improvements to data quality & searchability
- Ovum - new data
- More to come!

Looking forward

Reporting Enhancements

- Ability to select analysts, select interactions and select articles to be included in briefing books
- Ability to display report documents as web pages

Coverage Enhancements

- Make coverage group its own column on all finders (show only Region/Industry)
- Create coverages aliases
- Split out the vendor coverage as a new field

Looking forward

Event Management Enhancements

- Make analyst and executive itineraries available on mobile devices in real time
- Be able to define event characteristics to drive all event related interactions and reports
- Ability to display individual itineraries (analyst, executive and room) in a calendar view
- Ability to create a master event calendar

Notifications

- Another user added interaction to your analyst
- Your analyst published new content
- Reminders about upcoming interactions
- Follow up notifications on interactions
